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## Public transport

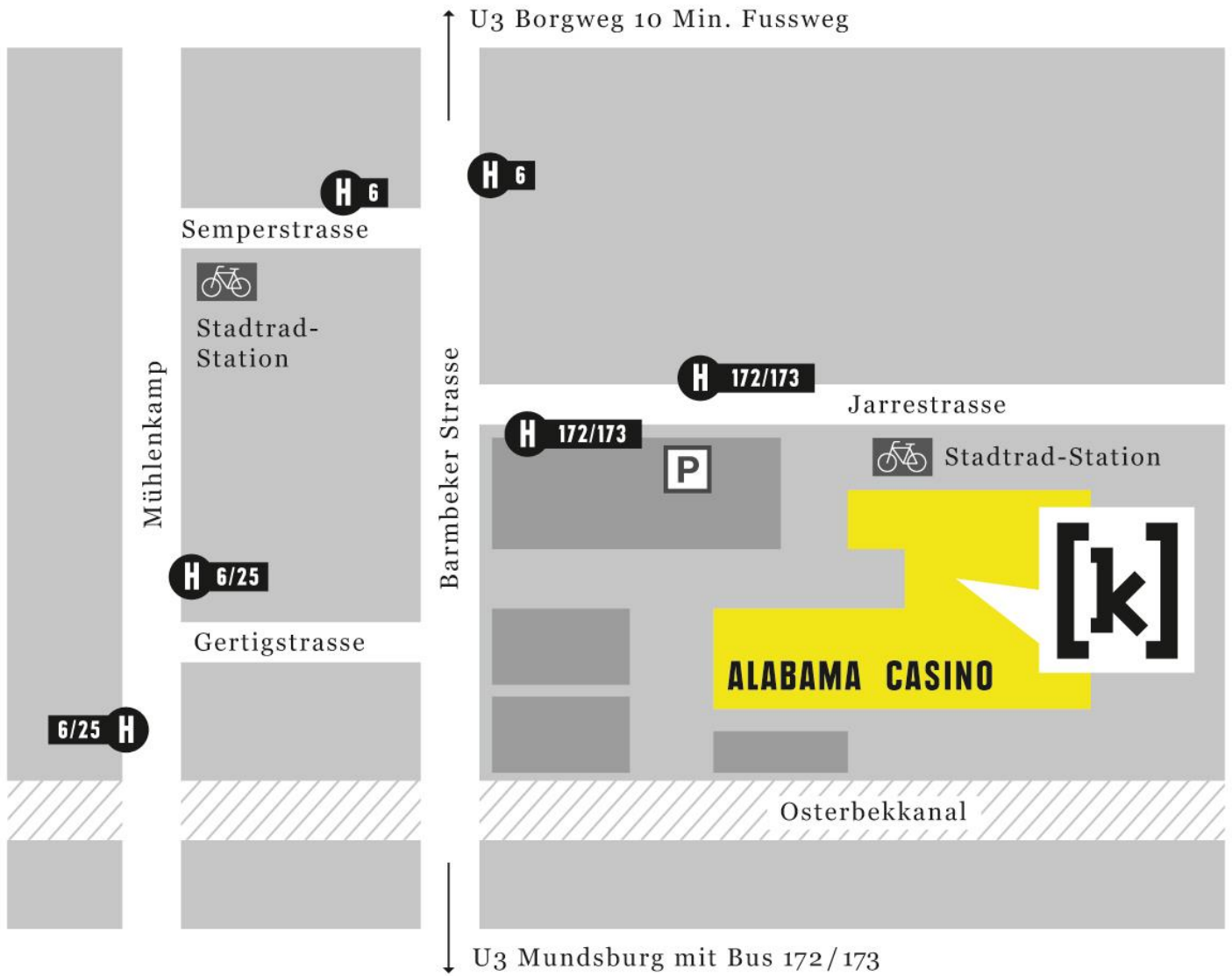
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### Bus

There are two buses from **Jarrestrasse** – #**172** and **173** in front of Kampnagel –to the station **U Mundsburg**. From there you can take the subway **U3** to the **central station**, to the **harbour** and to the **city center** (direction: Schlump).

### Subway

10 min. walk to the next subway station **U Barmbek**. From there you can take the subway **U3** going to the **central station**, the **harbour**, the **Reeperbahn** and to the city center. (direction: Schlump/Wandsbek- Gartenstadt). Way back to **Barmbek** take the **U3** (direction: Barmbek).

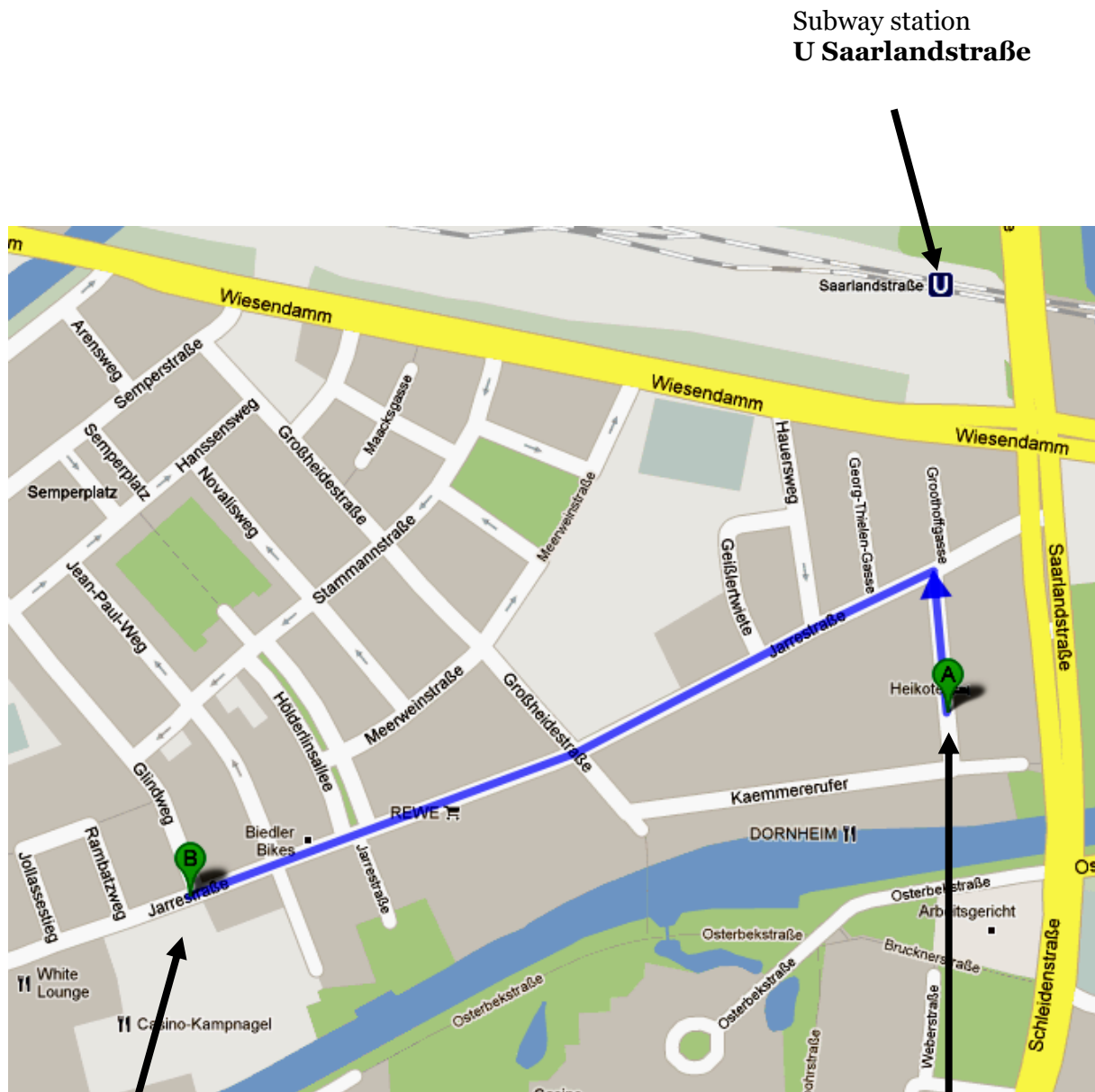

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## Important information

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### Performance Tickets

If you want to see other performances at Kampnagel, please contact your production manager in charge. We will try to find the best possible arrangement.

### Water bottles

Everyone of your group gets his / her own Kampnagel water bottle. Please write down your name and don't lose it. You can refill the bottles backstage. Of course you can keep them afterwards.

### Banks

Most banks are open from 9:30am to 6:00pm on weekdays. They change foreign currency and cash traveller's cheques. Generally the rates in banks are better than in hotels or "Bureaus de Change". The closest bank is: **Haspa** (Hamburger Sparkasse), Jarrestraße 28

### Post Office

There is a Post Office in the Avanti Kiosk, Jarrestraße 26. They are open weekdays from 6:00am to 10:00pm and Saturdays from 8:00am to 10:00pm. Post offices and letter boxes are yellow and easy to recognize. A standard letter/postcard within Germany and to most EU-countries costs 0,58 €. To almost every other country 0,75 €.

### Places to relax

**Close to Kampnagel:** Stadtpark (public park), Außenalster (lake)

**Close to the city center:** Planten un Blomen (public park)

**Surroundings:** Altes Land (fruit-plantages, little canals), Övelgönne (Elb beach), Jenischpark

### Laundry

For performance-costumes there are washing and drying machines in the dressing rooms of k2 and k6. If you need to wash and you are not in one of these dressing rooms please feel free to ask your artist companion.

### Shopping – Sightseeing – Nightlife

**City center:** There are three big inner city shopping areas in Hamburg, with all typical boring inner city stores all within walking distance from the Hauptbahnhof: **Mönckebergstraße**, **Jungfernstieg** and **Rathausplatz**.

Nicer districts for shopping, nightlife etc. are: **Altona** (around Ottenser Hauptstr.), **St. Georg** (along Lange Reihe), **Sternschanze** (around Schanzenstr. and Marktstr. with alternative food and clothing stores) and **St. Pauli** (NOT on the Reeperbahn).

If you want to visit the **harbour**, take the **U3** or the **S-1 or S-3** and get off at **Landungsbrücken**, where you can either take one of several harbour tour ships for tourists, or (by using your normal bus and metro day ticket) take the HVV-ship to the **Fischmarkt** or to **Övelgönne**, where you can take a walk along the river.

### Bike rental "StadtRAD Hamburg"

At Jarrestrasse is a bike-hire-station. The registration fee is € 5,- (incl. a € 5.00 credit). You need an EC-card or credit card to register. You can return bikes at any hire station which you'll find in maps at the back of the every terminal. The costs will be charged from your account once in a month.

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## About Kampnagel

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Kampnagel is Germany's largest production and performance facility for national and international freelance artists and is one of the most reputable venue for the performing arts. In 1984, after the Deutsche Schauspielhaus had left the venue, the former crane factory was rebuilt into a multifunctional theatre building. Each season, with its six stages, the cinema, rehearsal space and the restaurant, Kampnagel attracts tens of thousands of visitors.

We offer a wide range of different productions to our visitors, from international guest performances, the international summer festival and the emphasis on certain topics, the productions of freelance theater groups in Hamburg and the support of the new blood artists. We present a spectrum of aesthetical standpoints and groundbreaking tendencies not only in theater, dance and performance, but also in music, the fine arts and architecture.

Kampnagel is a productive laboratory for ideas, a think tank, a place for controversy, but also a vivid concert hall, music lounge, club. We work on new formats, that seek to explore contemporary forms of public life, communication, interaction, participation and knowledge transfer.

Kampnagel is not only a temple for the fine arts. It is open to the society and the surroundings. We understand Hamburg as not only the city being inhabited by our visitors, but also as a field to be explored, a place stocked with new material, a site worth investigating and of course as a stage, which we enter with mobile formats.

As a whole, we present roughly 100 premieres, debut performances and nonrecurring even per season, which attract over 165.000 visitors per season each year.

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# History

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## KAMPNAGEL

... in former times a famous factory in the Hamburg workers district of Barmbek – today an international centre for the contemporary representative arts:

### THE FACTORY ERA:

- 1865**            Founded as Nagel & Kaemp ironworks.
- 1875-1968**    Production of large-scale machinery; initially rice mills and then primarily cargo equipment and cranes. Even today, Kampnagel Cranes can be found in harbours all over the world. During this time stages the novel "Maschinenfabrik N&K" (Machine Factory N&K) by Willi Bredel, depicting the story of the aborted 1923 workers' uprising against the Weimar Republic.
- 1939**            Armament factory
- 1945**            Re-opening of the civil production of cargo equipment for ships and harbours
- 1968**            As a result of the triumph of the container technology, the demand for traditional Kampnagel products is reduced. The factory is sold to the Demag Corporation and fork-lift trucks are manufactured on the premises until 1981.

### THE THEATRE ERA:

- 1981**            with the closure of the manufacturing plant ends the factory era of Kampnagel. The senate and district plan to demolish the halls and construct a housing estate; the demolition is initially suspended.
- 1982**            "DEUTSCHES SCHAUSPIELHAUS" uses a part of the building during the refurbishment of their main building on the Kirchenallee as the headquarter for the whole company, for direction and administration over workplaces and rehearsal stages through to performance venues.
- The first festival "**BESETZUNGSPROBE**" on the premises is organised by the Hamburg freelance theatre groups who see an ideal production and performance space for their work here.
- 1985**            From March onwards there is a continuous run of performances at **KAMPNAGEL** under the commercial direction of **Hannah Hurtzig** and **Mücke Quinckardt**. In July/August: regular **INTERNATIONAL SUMMER FESTIVAL** under the direction of **Dieter Jaenicke**. To begin with, the premises are supported by the Hamburg Cultural Authority.
- 1986**            The first women's festival on the premises, "**HAMMONIALE**", under the direction of **Irmgard Schleier**; since then, the festival takes place in a biennial cycle, with sponsorship from societies; since 1995 it has been produced under the artistic direction of Isabella Vertes-Schütter and Irmgard Schleier.

- 1987** **INTERNATIONAL THEATRE-DANCE FESTIVAL**, staged by the Hamburg State Opera; subsequent regular performances in the hall [k6] put on by the State Opera with works by people such as **Robert Wilson** and **John Neumeier**, amongst others.
- Official opening of the gallery [kx] in the administration headquarters; the gallery is run by a self-governing committee and regularly presents exhibitions, installations and performances by contemporary and international artists.
- Official opening of the exhibition room [k3] with "New Art in Hamburg", curated by the director of the Art Society, Karl-Egon Vester.
- 1990** Appointment of a Kampnagel council. New leadership: **Hans Man in 't Veld** and **Wolfram Kremer**, who are responsible for the regular programme of performances in the halls.
- 1991** Jürgen Zielinski launches a project under the name "**YOUTH THEATRE FOR HAMBURG AT KAMPNAGEL**" (JAK), to create an independent Hamburg youth theatre.
- 1998** The Cultural Authority of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg decides on a **structural reform of Kampnagel**: Starting from the 2001/2002 season, the Kampnagel International Culture Factory Ltd is not only a company institution, but also stages a theatre festival in the summer, to replace the formerly independent "Hamburg International Summer Theatre Festival".
- Ceremonial opening** of Kampnagel and commencement of the 1998/99 season with the Japanese theatre performance Dumb Type.
- 2001** the new artistic director Gordana Vnuk introduces herself to the audience for the first time with the new Kampnagel Summer Festival, **LAOKOON**. In 2002, the Japanese theatre expert, Hidenaga Otori, takes over the artistic direction of the festival for three years.
- The long-term future of Kampnagel is secured by the completion of a tenancy agreement with the Sprinkenhof AG, for a period of 15 years.
- Gordana Vnuk opens her first season with a spectacular European premiere – the Japanese group **ISHINHA** present their Jan-Jan opera "Ryusei".
- 2007** **Amelie Deuffhard opens her first season at Kampnagel** with the **BESETZUNGSORGIE** with Alvis Hermanis' „Sonja”, Gutierrez' "Retrospective exhibitionist", the Orchestra-Karaoke, a concert by Decembrists and many other performances. The event takes place all over the entire Kampnagel-area and attracts over 3000 people.
- Kampnagel **K3 - center for choreography/dance plan Hamburg opens** with a three-day-long happening with the imaginative choreographer Veronika Blumstein. K3 is a project of Tanzplan Deutschland, which aims to strengthen contemporary dance in Germany.



- 2008** The **INTERNATIONAL SOMMERFESTIVAL HAMBURG 2008** under the new direction of **Matthias von Hartz** immediately gains approval with a record of nearly 19,000 visitors. Apart from dance and theatre world premieres for the first time there is a rich music program as well as expert lectures on contemporary socio-economical topics.
- 2009** Kampnagel dance dramaturgs Jochen Roller and Anne Kersting curate the first **LIVE ART FESTIVAL**, which will take place for five years in cooperation with seven European partners at Kampnagel.
- Eva Maria Stütting curates the **YOUNGSTAR FEST**. The first performing arts festival by youngsters for youngsters. International, professional artists develop and present productions together with pupils from Hamburg.
- New visitors record at the **INTERNATIONAL SUMMER FESTIVAL HAMBURG. 20,500 guests** visit Kampnagel.
- The **DANCE CONGRESS 2009** organized by **Katharina von Wilcke and Sabine Gehm** at Kampnagel gains an overwhelming success. Over 3000 dance-creative and dance-interested participate at the four-day congress.
- 2010** Kampnagel is the pulsating center for finer arts in Hamburg: Artistic Director Amelie Deuflhard and their team announce the **2009/10 record of attendances of 143.000 spectators.**
- With the coproduction of Nature theatre of Oklaohma and Philippe Quesne as well as a complete program of dance, theater, art and lectures the 2010 **INTERNATIONAL SOMMERFESTIVAL HAMBURG** establishes another **audience record with over 28,000 visitors.**
- Amelie Deuflhard extends her contract as Artistic Director of Kampnagel until 2017. "Amelie Deuflhard strengthened Kampnagel role as an internationally relevant place performing arts" says Reinhard Stuth, Hamburg's senator for culture and media.
- 2013** András Siebold becomes the new artistic director of the International Summerfestival Hamburg 2013...
